Sub: Directions issued to MBBS students by the Institutional Covid Cell held on 09/12/2020

Ref: Decision taken by the Institutional Covid Cell held @ 9.30 a.m. on 09/12/2020

All students must submit a RTPCR negative report at the time of reporting to the College/Hostel premises. They will be subjected to thermal screening and only those who are asymptomatic would be allowed inside the hostel. A declaration regarding the same would be collected.

All students irrespective of day-scholars should stay in the hostel designated for them and follow the rules as mentioned.

Every student should undergo 7 days quarantine at the hostel where they would be allotted a single room. Students should report any symptoms that may arise during this period.

On the completion of 7th day of quarantine, students would need to undergo an Antigen test, following which those reporting negative would be allotted rooms in hostels on double occupancy basis.

All students should undergo strict room quarantine and must wear face mask when going outside the rooms even inside the hostel.

Food would be provided in the hostel and no food delivery from outside would be entertained. All parcel/courier would be released to the student only after 3 days subject to disinfection.

Anyone violating the quarantine protocol will be quarantined for further 7 days and should submit a RTPCR result to re-join.

Only those students with negative antigen result after quarantine period are permitted to enter into the hospital premises for clinical posting.

All students should wear a mask and face shield inside the hospital and should wear a pair of gloves on bedside while handling the patients.

Students should not loiter around inside the hospital building during posting hours and should remain in the designated rooms of the concerned departments. Students are strictly prohibited from going out of the campus.

During clinical postings, if any student develops any symptom, it should duly be reported to Head of the concerned departments and the student should seek treatment at the Infectious disease OPD near Emergency department for further evaluation.
