Principal's Desk



Pushpagiri Institute of Medical Sciences & Research Centre, the first private medical college in the state of Kerala has produced around 1500 MBBS graduates and 350 Postgraduates over the past two decades. Having an alumni association is the privilege of students graduating from the institution. Apart from forming a strong bond with their alma mater, it provides them opportunities for networking and growth. The institution also gets benefited as the Alumni will be able to provide opportunities for career guidance & progression to our students. Pushpagiri Medical College Association was registered with the Kerala government on 23. 07. 2022 with Dr. Rohit John Cheriyl and Dr. Anil Sam as the President and Secretary respectively. The association made a humble beginning with only 7 members . Gradually it has expanded over a period of 6 months to include around 550 members. Many of our alumni members take up postgraduate courses, and some of them have joined as faculty in our institution. ACT NOW. END LEPROSY

World Leprosy day is observed every year on the last Sunday of January. It was chosen by French humanitarian Raoul Follereau in 1953. In India, Leprosy Day is observed on 30th January every year, coinciding with the death anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi. This international day is an opportunity to celebrate people who have experienced leprosy, raise awareness of the disease and call for an end to leprosy-related stigma and discrimination. Leprosy is a neglected tropical disease (NTD) which still occurs in more than 120 countries. The theme of World Leprosy Day 2023 is "Act now. End leprosy." This calls attention to three key messages.

- ❁ Elimination is possible: We have the power and tools to stop transmission and defeat this disease.
- ❁ Act now: We need the resources and commitment to end leprosy. Prioritize leprosy Elimination.
- ❁ Reach the unreached: Leprosy is preventable and treatable. Suffering from leprosy is needless.

The Global Leprosy (Hansen's disease) strategy 2021-2030 is "Towards Zero Leprosy." Long term vision is zero leprosy: zero infection and disease, zero disability, zero stigma and discrimination. Global targets for 2030 are (1) 120 countries with zero new autochthonous cases (2) 70% reduction in annual number of new cases detected (3) 90% reduction in rate per million population of new cases with grade – 2 disability (G2D) (4) 90% reduction in rate per million children of new child cases with leprosy. Although around 200,000 people were diagnosed with leprosy each year before COVID 19, this number has fallen by 30% because of disruptions caused by the pandemic to leprosy programmes. Many million are living with leprosy-related disabilities particularly across Asia, Africa, and South America. Leprosy is atleast 4,000 years old making it one of the oldest diseases known to humanity. However we believe we can be the generation that finally ends the transmission of leprosy.

REVISED BASIC COURSE WORKSHOP IN MEDICAL EDUCATION TECHNOLOGIES

The sixth revised Basic Course Workshop in Medical Education Technologies (BCMET) was conducted by the Medical Education Department, PIMS & RC from Jan 23rd to 25th, 2023. This workshop was conducted as per the NMC Guidelines, and under the observership of Dr. Geethadevi M, Associate Professor of Community Medicine and Resource faculty, NMC Nodal Center for Faculty Development, GMC, Kottayam. The workshop was conducted in the MEU Conference Hall /Skills lab, second floor of the Medical College Annex Building. Thirty faculty from the Institute underwent training in the workshop.

Faculty training workshops in Medical Education Technologies are mandated by NMC for all teaching faculty from Assistant Professor and above in all recognized medical colleges across the country. The faculty need to undergo the training once every 5 years in order to update them with newer technologies and empower them to implement the curricular changes that occur from time to time to meet the changing needs of the curriculum.

In our institution, two faculty training workshops were conducted prior to the MCI mandate, and issuance of uniform guidelines throughout the country. Following the MCI mandate and guidelines, four workshops in BCMET were conducted from 2013-2015. This was followed by a revised curriculum of the workshop by the MCI with the incorporation of concepts of CBME and AETCOM. Following the revision of the workshop guidelines, six revised BCMET had been conducted on the campus from 2017 till date.



ONE DAY NATIONAL WORKSHOP- CENTRAL LIBRARY

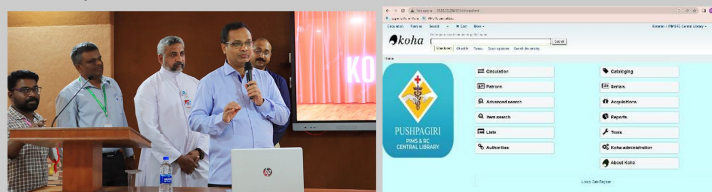

St. Thomas Orthodox Church, Pongamthanam

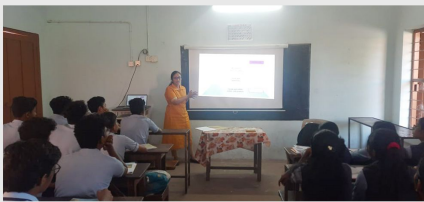

Pushpagiri Medical College Men's team won third position in the KUHS B Zone Basketball Tournament held in Kottayam.



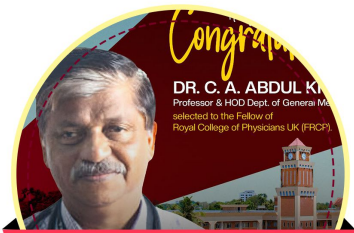
PREM NAZIR AWARD 2023- DR. V. P SASHIDHARAN
